This fund update was first made publicly available on 29 October 2021.

1. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the QuayStreet Conservative Fund (Conservative Fund) has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Fund with other funds. QuayStreet Asset Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

The QuayStreet Conservative Fund invests in a diversified portfolio with an emphasis on conservative assets such as fixed interest investments. The investment objective is to provide a return above the Fund's benchmark over the long term.

3. WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

RISK INDICATOR FOR THE CONSERVATIVE FUND

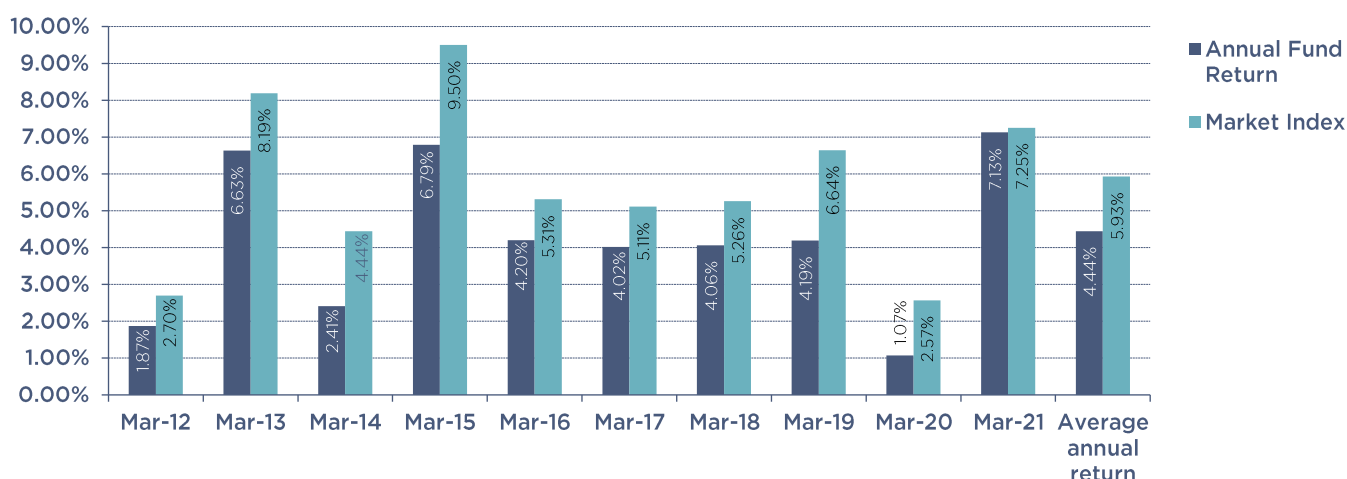

6. EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

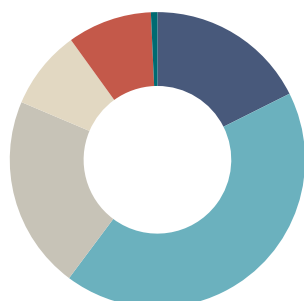
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Emma had \$50,000 in the Fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Emma received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,940.00 (that is 3.88% of her initial \$50,000). Emma did not pay any other charges. This gives Emma a total return after tax of \$1,755.00 for the year.

CURRENCY EXPOSURE - The Fund's foreign currency exposure is actively managed in a manner consistent with the investment objectives and the performance benchmark. The current (after derivatives) exposure to foreign currencies is 10% compared to the benchmark foreign currency exposure of 10%.
