QuayStreet Fixed Interest Fund

QUARTER ENDED 30 JUNE 2022

This fund update was first made publicly available on 26 July 2022.

1. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the QuayStreet Fixed Interest Fund (Fixed Interest Fund) has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. QuayStreet Asset Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

The QuayStreet Fixed Interest Fund invests in a diversified portfolio of fixed interest and derivative investments, with an emphasis on corporate bonds. The investment objective is to provide a level of return above the New Zealand corporate fixed interest market over the long term, consistent with the fund's benchmark. The fund aims to make quarterly distributions.

3. WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

RISK INDICATOR FOR THE FIXED INTEREST FUND

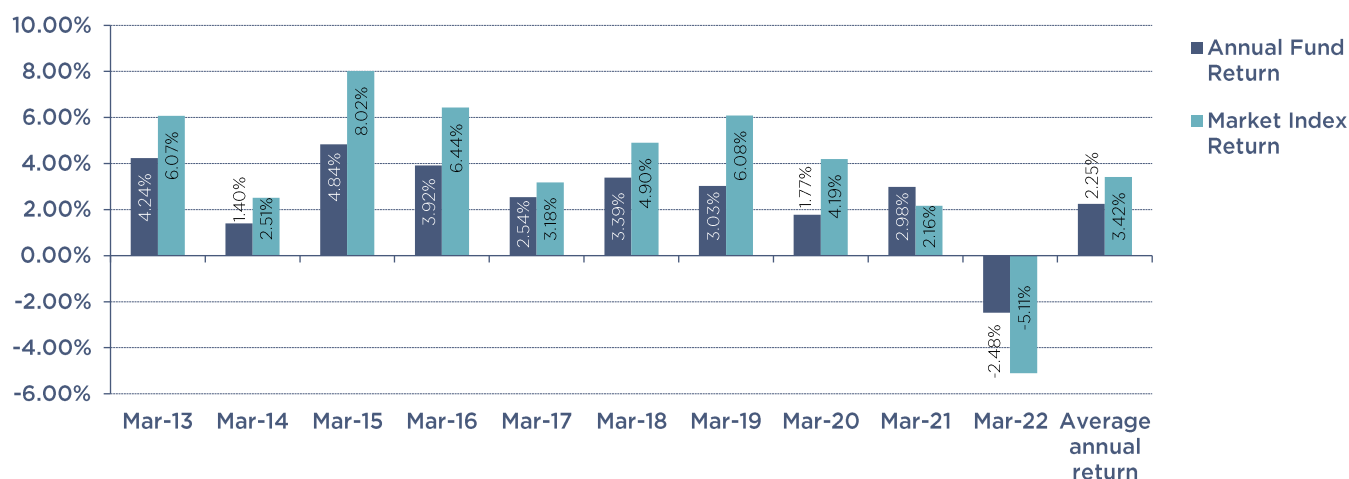

6. EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Emma had \$50,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Emma incurred a loss after fund charges were deducted of \$2,980.00 (that is -5.96% of her initial \$50,000). Emma did not pay any other charges. This gives Emma a total loss after tax of \$2,155.00 for the year.
