1. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the QuayStreet New Zealand Equity Fund (New Zealand Equity Fund) has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Fund with other funds. QuayStreet Asset Management Limited has prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

A portfolio of shares from our local market targeting a return above the long term performance of the New Zealand share market.

3. WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

RISK INDICATOR FOR THE NEW ZEALAND EQUITY FUND

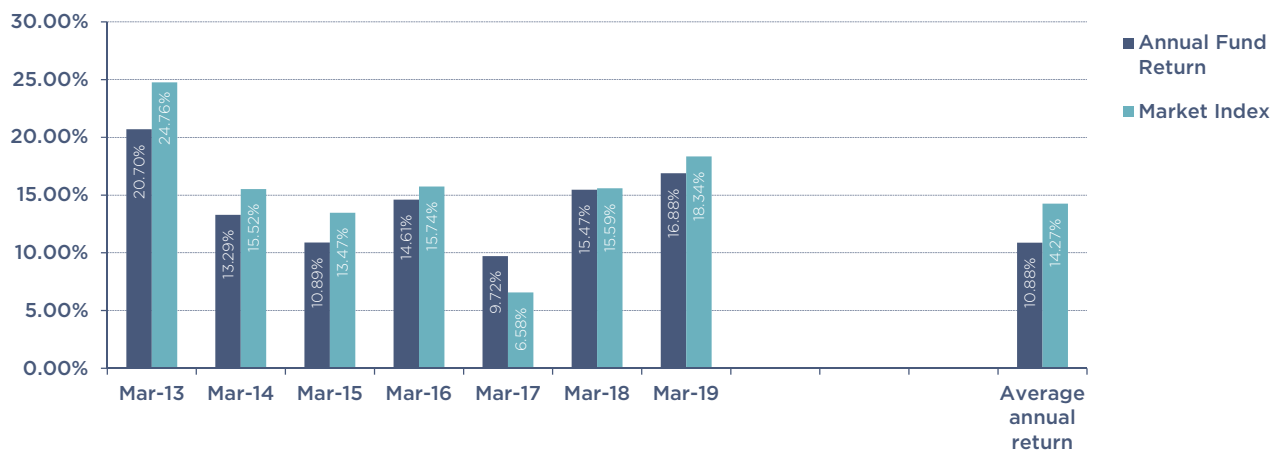

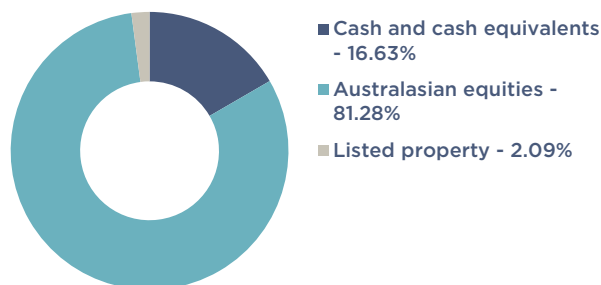
EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Emma has \$50,000 in the Fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Emma received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$8,735.00 (that is 17.47% of her initial \$50,000). Emma paid \$40.04 in other charges. This gives Emma a total return after tax of \$8,264.96 for the year.
