

QuayStreet New Zealand Equity Fund QUARTER ENDED 30 JUNE 2021

This fund update was first made publicly available on 28 July 2021.

1. WHAT IS THE PURPOSE OF THIS UPDATE?

This document tells you how the QuayStreet New Zealand Equity Fund (New Zealand Equity Fund) has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the Fund with other funds. QuayStreet Asset Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

2. DESCRIPTION OF THIS FUND

The QuayStreet New Zealand Equity Fund invests in a portfolio of shares from the New Zealand market, targeting returns above the long-term performance of the New Zealand sharemarket. The investment objective is to provide investors with a level of return over the long term above the Fund's benchmark.

3. WHAT ARE THE RISKS OF INVESTING?

The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.



5. WHAT FEES ARE INVESTORS CHARGED?

Investors in QuayStreet New Zealand Equity Fund are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2021 these were:

Administration Fee Up to \$30.00 per annum per member charged to your member account in September and March. Approximately \$4.57 per annum per member. This estimate has been based on the total amount of costs and expenses recovered during the Scheme's previous financial year on a per member basis. The actual expenses incurred will vary from time to time and are recovered on a per member basis.

6. EXAMPLE OF HOW THIS APPLIES TO AN INVESTOR

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Emma had \$50,000 in the Fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Emma received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$5,730.00 (that is 11.46% of her initial \$50,000). Emma paid \$34.57 in other charges. This gives Emma a total return after tax of \$5,485.43 for the year.
